HOW TO REGISTER TO DONATE AND BID ON AUCTION PACKAGES

1. Go to raphaelhouse.com/gala22 and click the purple "REGISTER TO BID" button at the top of the page.
2. Click "GET STARTED" in the upper right-hand corner.
3. Log in to an existing account and skip to step 6 - OR - click green "CREATE ACCOUNT" button.
4. Enter email address, complete captcha, and click "CONFIRM."
5. You will then receive a confirmation email from Greater Giving Login. Click the link in the email to confirm registration.
Note: check your junk folder.
6. Complete account information, and click "CREATE."
7. Click "START BIDDING" to browse packages.
8. Scroll down to view and bid on auction packages.
Click "DONATE NOW" to make a gift.

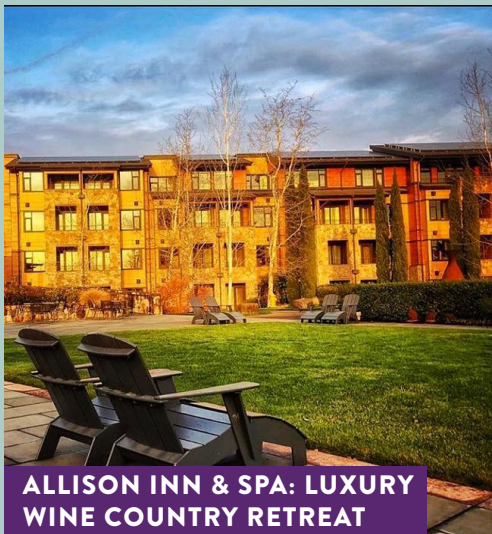

For 45 years, Raphael House of Portland has helped domestic violence survivors find the safety and independence they deserve. PREVENTION EDUCATION

Through education, we are working upstream to stop violence before it starts. Our workshops teach young people and adults how to build equitable relationships, practice consent, and identify and respond to domestic violence.

EMERGENCY SERVICES
