- **\$25 VISA gift cards** – so parents can choose the perfect gifts for their families!
- **Children** – Lego sets, games, toys, active play/ recreational item including scooters and skateboards with helmets, high-quality art supply sets, baby dolls with black and brown skin, drawing pads
- **Teens** – multimedia art supply sets, high-quality backpacks, wireless headphones, Bluetooth speakers, Fred Meyer gift cards
- **Kitchen** – 16-piece dish sets, spoon and fork sets, cooking utensil sets, can openers, pizza cutters, cereal bowl sets, kitchen towels, oven mitts
- **Personal care** – full-sized bottles of African American hair products, shampoo and conditioner, body wash, and lotion; adult and youth toothbrushes and toothpaste, razors, deodorant, dental floss
- **Household** – full-sized comforters, twin sheet sets, pillows, bath towel sets, hangers, rectangular laundry baskets, HE pod laundry detergent, 9 volt batteries, 33-gallon trash bags, gallon and quart Ziploc bags
- **Clothing essentials** – women and teen sized L-4XL hoodies and leggings, girls' socks and underwear, boys' socks and underwear, women's underwear, sports bras, teen/men's boxer briefs, men's socks
- **Babies** – full-sized bottles of baby shampoo, body wash, and lotion, baby toys

Your financial gifts help us provide survivors with the things they need most, like:

\$10 – fresh produce and food for a whole day of healthy meals for a family.

\$30 – cab ride to help a new family get to our shelter safely.

\$50 – housing application fee to help a family transition out of our shelter

\$80 - access to Community Warehouse's furniture bank, so a family can furnish their new home.

\$100 – 24-hours of safe shelter for an adult or child fleeing domestic violence.

\$250 – sponsor two support groups for survivors, including facilitation and childcare.
