- Children active play/interactive toys, Lego sets, games, high-quality art supply sets, toys/dolls (esp. with diverse skin tones)
- **Teens** multimedia art supply sets, wireless headphones, Bluetooth speakers, make-up sets (for diverse skin tones), high-quality backpacks, sports equipment, teen gifts.

Your financial gifts help us provide survivors with the resources they need most:

\$10 - fresh produce and food for a whole day of healthy meals for a family

\$30 – cab ride, so a new family can get to our emergency shelter safely

\$60 – housing application fee to help a family transition out of our shelter

\$80 - access to Community Warehouse's furniture bank, so a family can furnish their new home

\$100 - 24-hours of safe shelter for an adult or child fleeing domestic violence

\$250 – 2 weeks of support groups for survivors, including facilitation and childcare.

Each December – with help from hundreds of volunteers and donors – Raphael House of Portland transforms our Advocacy Center into a "store" filled with free items for survivors in our programs. More than 195 families come to our confidential location to pick out toys, kitchen appliances, gifts, and so much more. These items are 100% donated, so community support is essential and helps bring joy and hope during the holiday season!

During the campaign, we collect new and unwrapped items for adults, teens, and children, along with gift cards – so that survivors can choose the perfect gifts for themselves and their children. We also ask for vital supplies that will ensure families have what they need, and monetary donations that will help sustain our life-changing and life-saving services, year-round.
